The 2016 brings the fifth consecutive year of exceptional fruit harvested from America's premier wine region, Napa Valley.

An early bud break followed by warm weather and spring rains brought a rapid start to this year's near perfect growing season in the valley. The fruit enjoyed beautiful weather during bud break and plenty of time to hang on the vines. Although yields were down due to drought, the berries were nice and plump, which resulted in balanced and complex flavor profiles.
